THANKSGIVING FOOD DRIVE

Canned Goods: Cranberry sauce, Turkey gravy, Yams, Fruit, Vegetables (corn, carrots, green beans, peas)

Packaged Goods: Instant mashed potatoes or rice, Stuffing, Tea, coffee, or cocoa, Canned or shelf stable milk, or Juices (apple, cranberry, grape), Jell-O or pudding, Cake mix & icing, Non-frozen pie crust & filling, Brownie mix.

Please: No expired, dented or rusted cans, or opened or expired boxes or bags. Also, no glass bottles (breakable) or cellophane bags (crushable).

Please Remember: to mark, label, or attach this flyer to your donation bags or boxes and leave them on the Donation Tables near the elevator in the Church Hall. Frozen turkeys, etc., should be placed (unmarked) in the designated freezer adjacent to the kitchen area.
