

JANUARY 7, 2024 THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD



Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord Isaiah 60: 1-6
Psalm 72: 1-2, 7-8, 10-13 Ephesians 3: 2-3a, 5-6
Matthew 2: 1-12

The Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord reminds us that Christ came to save not only the chosen people of Israel, but all men and women. The Gospels, addressed to various audiences, clearly show that Christ came first (but not only) to save the people of Israel. However, it quickly becomes apparent that while salvation history began with the Jewish people, it ultimately expanded to encompass all of humanity. In a sense, it reveals the vast and eternal expanse of God's love for the whole world. "The Gentiles are coheirs, members of the same body, and copartners in the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel." (Ephesians 3:6)

Today's reading from Matthew's Gospel tells of the Magi, the wise men from the East, who had seen the star at its rising. They did not understand what it foretold, but they recognized it as a sign of great importance. It was they, rather than Herod and the chief priest and scribes of Israel, who opened their hearts and minds to the meaning of the star, and embarked on an arduous journey to discover the truth.

The Magi are models for all of us who seek to uncover the mysteries of faith. They persisted in their long journey and earnestly sought the meaning of the star. They did not seek to impose their own definition or interpretation of it; rather, they desired only knowledge of the newborn king so that they could do him homage. In a sense, they were the first disciples from the world of the Gentiles.

While we possess the gift of faith in Christ Jesus, would we undertake such a journey? Would we drop everything and travel to a far-away land in search of the truth? The scriptures never mention the magi after this passage. But I cannot help but think that they, or their heirs might have become members of the body of Christ as the early Church grew to surrounding nations. Their desire was genuine and deep and offers a model for all of us.

As we reflect upon the Epiphany during these final days of the Christmas Season (following the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord on Monday, January 8) and return to Ordinary Time, let us model our devotion to the faith on the Magi, who persevered in their desire for the truth: "They were overjoyed at seeing the star, and on entering the house they saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh." (Matthew 2: 10-11)

Parish Outreach for Q4 2023
