

JANUARY 19TH ~ THE SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



<u>January 19, 2025 – 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time</u> <u>Isaiah 62: 1-5 Psalm 96: 1-3, 7-10 1 Corinthians 12: 4-11</u> <u>John 2: 1-11</u>

"Jesus did this as the beginning of his signs at Cana in Galilee and so revealed his glory, and his disciples began to believe in him."

(John 2: 11)

The story of Jesus' first sign at the Wedding Feast at Cana is mentioned only in John's Gospel, but is familiar to us all. Jesus has changed water into wine – and not just any wine, but the best of wine. He does so at the behest of Mary, the Blessed Mother, which can be seen as a sign of her intercessory power. His actions of transformation, in a sense, "saving" the wedding feast can be seen as approval of marriage. The story is rich in symbolism and significance and marks the beginning of Jesus' public ministry.

One aspect of the Gospel that is often overlooked is the simple kindness of Jesus in a matter that could be described relatively trivial in its effect. Unlike other signs, there were no miraculous healings, no raising from the dead, no majestic transfiguration before his disciples in robes of dazzling white light, no suffering,

death and resurrection. The immediate effect of this sign was to ensure an adequate supply of wine for the wedding feast to safeguard the reputation of the host family. Yet at a more profound level, the sign reveals Jesus' power and character as he begins his salvific ministry – it reveals his presence in all aspects of our lives, in matters small as well as great.

Jesus was the same in all aspects of his life. He was Lord and Savior, the suffering servant, healer, teacher, leader. He was fully divine and fully human, submitting to the will of the Father in all things. His kindness and compassion extended to all aspects of life, whether they are awesome and miraculous in appearance, or in more "routine" things (although certainly, none of Jesus' signs can truly be called routine).

We are called to be disciples of Christ in all aspects of our life. He challenges us to be loving and merciful to all men and women every day. Faith is not a Sunday chore – it is a commitment to be lived out each day, whether we are performing deeds of great sacrifice or heroism, or treating each other with simple respect and decency. We are not Christians because of the lofty words we utter; we are Christians because of how we live those words by our daily actions in accordance with the Gospel message.

"There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone."

(1 Corinthians 12: 4-6)
