# AUGUST 27 ~ TWENTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



## 21<sup>st</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

Isa 22:19-23; Ps 138:1-3,6,8; Rom 11:33-36; Mt 16:13-20

*You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it. (Mt 16:18)*

If today's Gospel reading sounds familiar, it is! We heard it proclaimed in early July on the Feasts of Saints Peter and Paul. It appears just a few short weeks later in the context of Ordinary Time. Jesus' words were uttered in response to Peter's recognition, on behalf of the disciples, that Jesus is "the Christ, the Son of the living God." It is a reminder that an important aspect of Christ's mission was to found the Church so that his mission could continue throughout the centuries.

Peter, saint that he is, was a flawed impetuous man, a coarse fisherman who, while of deep convictions and faith, was not above weakness and denial. His journey was not simple, but in

humility and repentance, he turned time and again to the Lord to become the most steadfast of disciples. At once fearful and courageous, thoughtful and instinctive, he was nonetheless chosen by the Lord to be the leader of the infant Church after Christ ascended to the Father. Peter, like each of us, is best described as a "work-in-progress." Despite his assertions that he would never desert Jesus, he would deny him not once, but three times. Yet, he persisted, and returned to the Lord in faith, ultimately leading the early Church until his martyrdom years later.

The story of Peter is a story of hope. We may turn aside in life, succumbing to fear and temptation, yet return to the Savior to become an instrument of salvation. His example mirrors that of so many of the saints, those who lead lives of dissolution, only to at last accept the gift of faith, proclaiming Christ as the only way to the Father.

Let us hold Peter as the exemplar of human faith. Recognizing that we bring to the altar our entire being — our strengths, our talents, and our gifts, along with our weaknesses and frailties. If we allow the Lord to use us for his purposes, then we can truly become the means to his proper end — his redemptive mission of faith, hope and love.

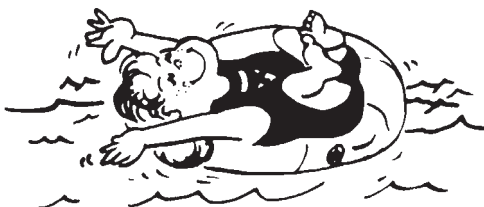
### PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO OUR LADY OF CZESTOCHOWA SHRINE

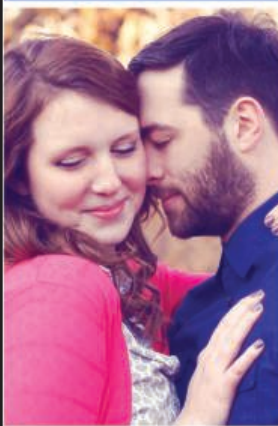
