What is a Miracle of the Eucharist?

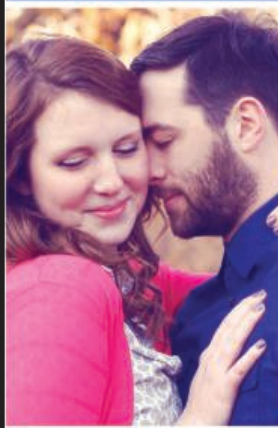
