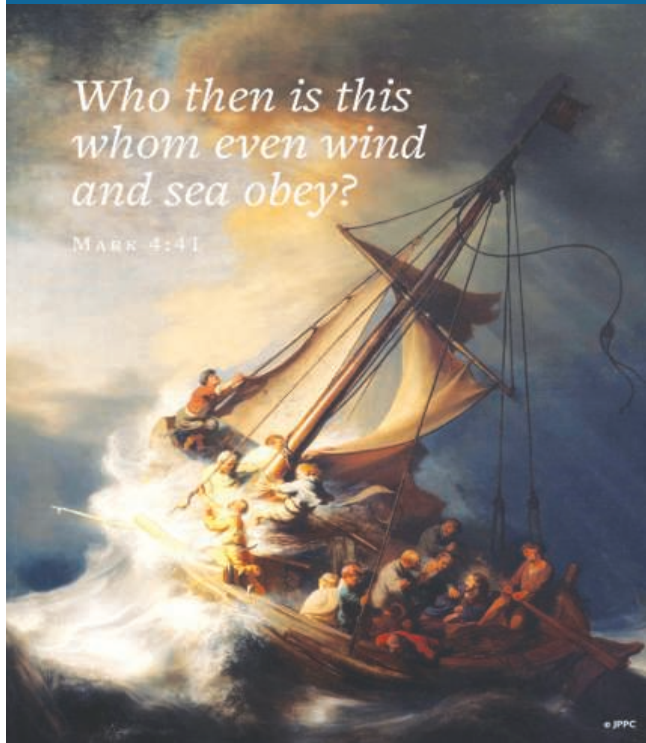

JUNE 23RD ~ THE TWELFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



Reflections
June 23, 2024 – 12th Sunday of Ordinary Time
Job 38: 1, 8-11 2 Corinthians 5: 14-17
Mark 4: 35-41

"Who then is this whom even the wind and sea obey?"
(Mark 4: 41b)

There are times in our lives when events seem to swirl about us, causing us great confusion and pain, when we seek even a moment's respite from turmoil. We are overwhelmed; even one thing more will cause us to lose our composure. It is in these times, that the Word of God, especially in our Sunday Liturgy, speaks to us with particular insight and clarity – as if the readings were chosen especially for us.

Indeed they are! The beauty and grace of the Word of God is its timely, yet eternal message of comfort and hope to those in need of solace. Consider the disciples. Confronted with the awesome power of a violent squall, they feared for their lives – the terrifying power of unrestrained nature was no match for their fragile craft. Yet, Jesus slept unafraid. When the disciples cried out to him, he rebuked the wind and calmed the sea. Even in nature, Jesus proclaimed a message of peace.

His very word brought tranquility.

We recognize, when we chose to do so, the power of the Lord in our own lives. As events spin out of control, we first seek to take control of all things in our misguided sense of omnipotence. Then, humbled by our own limitations, we open our hearts to the healing power of our Savior. What a paradox! In our humility, in our trust in the Lord, we are empowered by him – given the strength to endure all things, to become something more than we were in our human isolation.

Through Jesus, we are strengthened. Through him we are renewed for his purposes. Saint Paul reminds us that Christ died for all people, so that we might live no longer for ourselves, but for him. Our lives belong to God, yet in our submission to the Gospel of Christ, we are empowered with a freedom that emboldens, ennobles, and energizes us to proclaim his message of eternal salvation to the world.

"So whoever is in Christ is a new creation: the old things have passed away; behold, new things have come."

(2 Corinthians 5: 17)

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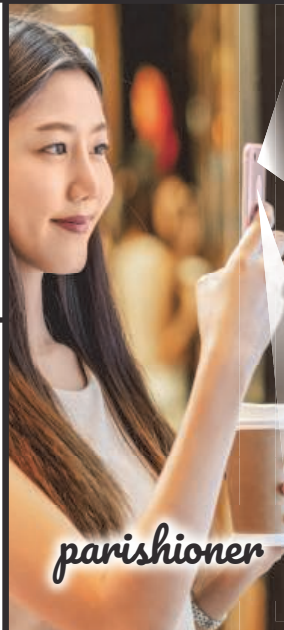


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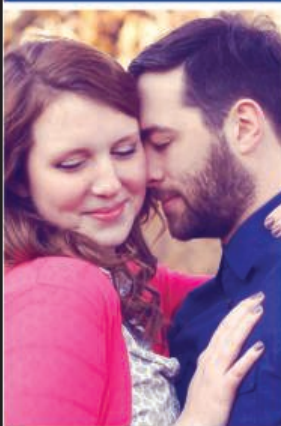
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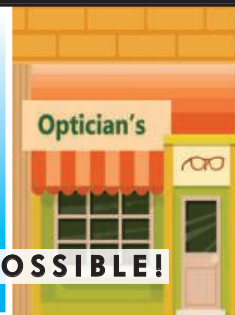
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
