

Easter Sunday, Resurrection of the Lord

Acts 10:34a,37-43; Ps 118:1-2,16-17,22-23; Col3:1-4, Jn 20:1-9

Do not be afraid! I know that you are seeking Jesus the crucified. He is not here, for he has been raised just as he said. (Mt 28:5b-6a)

In the early hours of dawn, the two women made their way to the tomb. As they approached, the earth quaked, and the angel of the Lord rolled back the stone and sat upon it; the guards were seemed to be dead. Mary Magdalene and the other woman named Mary approached. The angel spoke, proclaiming the wondrous news of Jesus' resurrection. As they hurried away to tell the disciples, Jesus met and greeted them. They embraced his feet and did him homage. Telling them to not be afraid, he instructed them to tell his brothers to go to Galilee where they would see him.

Dawn always follows the darkness; so too the light of Christ will always conquer the darkness of sin. As were the women that early morn, we are called to see the empty tomb and spread the good news: Christ has died! Christ is risen! Christ will come again.

Are you an adult, 19 years or older? Single for any reason? Employed? In college? Looking for friends to do group activities consistent with living your faith in Christ?


Come check out "The Community C.O.F.F.E.E. Club" on Friday, April 5th at 7 PM in the Parish Hall.
