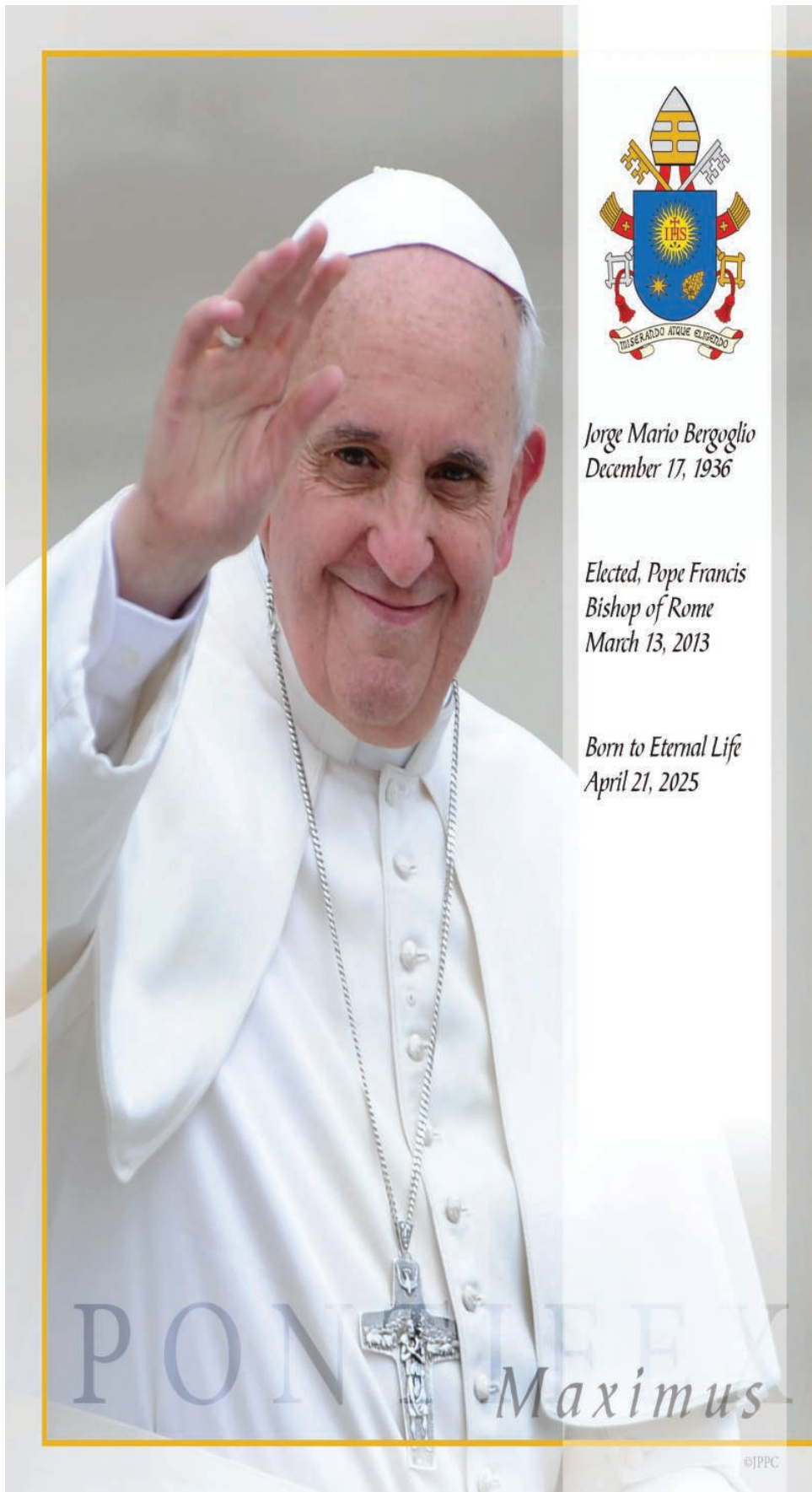




Heavenly Father,

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THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER ~ MAY 4, 2025



Reflection

May 4, 2025 – Third Sunday of Easter

Acts 5: 27-32, 40b-41 Psalm 30: 2, 4-6, 11-13

Revelation 5: 11-14 John 21: 1-19

“Sing praise to the LORD, you his faithful ones, and give thanks to his holy name. For his anger lasts but a moment; a lifetime, his good will. At nightfall, weeping enters in, but with the dawn rejoicing.”
(Psalm 30: 5-6)

For a third time after his resurrection, Jesus revealed himself to his disciples. This time, it was on the shore of the Sea of Tiberias. The disciples had been out fishing, without success. Standing on the shore, Jesus called to them to lower their nets once more. This time, they caught 153 fish. When they came to shore, Jesus, who had prepared a charcoal fire, gave them bread and fish for them to eat. Afterwards, as the disciples sat by the fire, Jesus turned to Peter and said, “Simon [Peter], son of John, do you love me more than these?” One can only imagine what Peter must have been thinking. After all, not long ago, Peter had denied Jesus, not once, but several times. “Yes, Lord, you know that I love you,” Peter replied. Jesus then said, “Feed my lambs.”

However, when Jesus asked a second, and then a third, time, Peter became distressed. Had he lost the Lord’s favor forever? Would there be no forgiveness, no return to a place of confidence and trust?

What Peter failed to realize, at least at first, was that the Lord was reaching out in loving forgiveness, in a sense, pulling him back from the brink of despair and guilt. Like Judas, Peter had turned away from the face of the Lord; unlike Judas, Peter turned again to the Lord in faith and love. With faith in the Lord, and the help of the Holy Spirit, Peter would remain the steadfast leader and disciple for the rest of his life. Even facing death, he remained faithful to the Lord.

There are times when we may turn away from the face of the Lord, times when we succumb to temptation and deny our faith in the risen Christ. Yet the Lord continually reaches out to us in loving forgiveness, inviting us to enter into an intimate relationship with him. In the grey light of dawn, he calls us out of the darkness of sin and despair, not to a life of comfort and ease, but to a life as devoted witness to the Gospel message. The road may be hard, but with his grace and strength, we shall be nourished in the breaking of the Bread of Life to follow him – for his glory, not ours.

“Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power and riches, wisdom and strength, honor and glory and blessing.” (Revelation 5: 12)

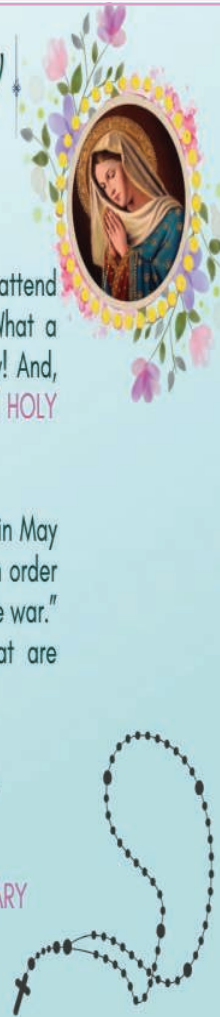
OLGCC ~ ROSARY GROUP

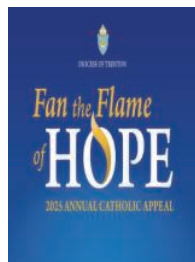

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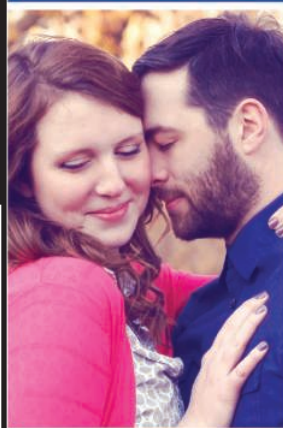
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
