Reflection

Reading I: Deuteronomy 6:2-6
Responsorial Psalm: 18:2-3, 3-4, 47, 51
Reading II: Hebrews 7:23-28
Gospel: Mark 12:28b-34

“The Lord our God is Lord alone! You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength . . . You shall love your neighbor as yourself.” (Mark 12: 29b-31a)

Jesus certainly makes things simple! Love God; love neighbor. When you think about it, the Gospel message centers upon this utterly profound reading. God loves us; we are called to respond in love to Him and all men and women.

How often do we complicate things? We probe, analyze, scrutinize, question . . . we formulate goals, strategies, tactics, actions, policies, procedures . . . in a way, not different from the scribes and Pharisees of Jesus’ time. Yet, in the end, it all comes back to love. Jesus’ words echoed those of Moses as proclaimed in our first reading. Taken from Deuteronomy, the first reading follows Moses’ giving of the Ten Commandments and precedes the numerous rules and regulations that marked the covenant of the LORD with the people of Israel. Yet, the great commandment remained the heart of this covenant.

God is love – Father, Son and Holy Spirit, often expressed as Creator, Redeemer and Sanctifier. The Blessed Trinity manifests Itself as the eternal perfect loving relationship. The Father created the World, the Son redeemed the World, and the Holy Spirit makes holy the World. All are one God, yet distinct persons. God reaches out to us in an ongoing *invitation to love*. We are called to respond in love to Him and to all humanity in all aspects of our being.

When we profess our faith in Christ, and offer ourselves in loving relationship, then we too “. . . are not far from the kingdom of God.

“I love you, O LORD, my strength, O LORD, my rock, my fortress, my deliverer.” (Psalm 18: 2-3a)

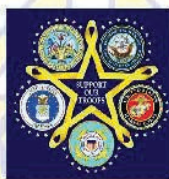

The Ewing Knights of Columbus are dedicated to bringing warmth to underprivileged young children through their annual Coats for Kids initiative.

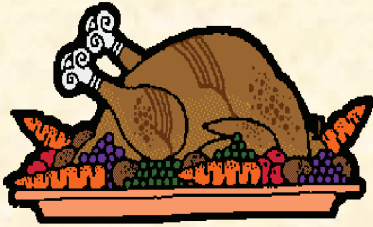
